


#### HOW TO AVOID UNSAFE DRIVING VIOLATIONS:

O Don't Follow too close


Use turn signal when change lanes

# **HOW TO AVOID DRIVER FITNESS VIOLATIONS:**


- O Have medical card in your possession O Must have valid license for type



hanging parts anywhere on the truck


