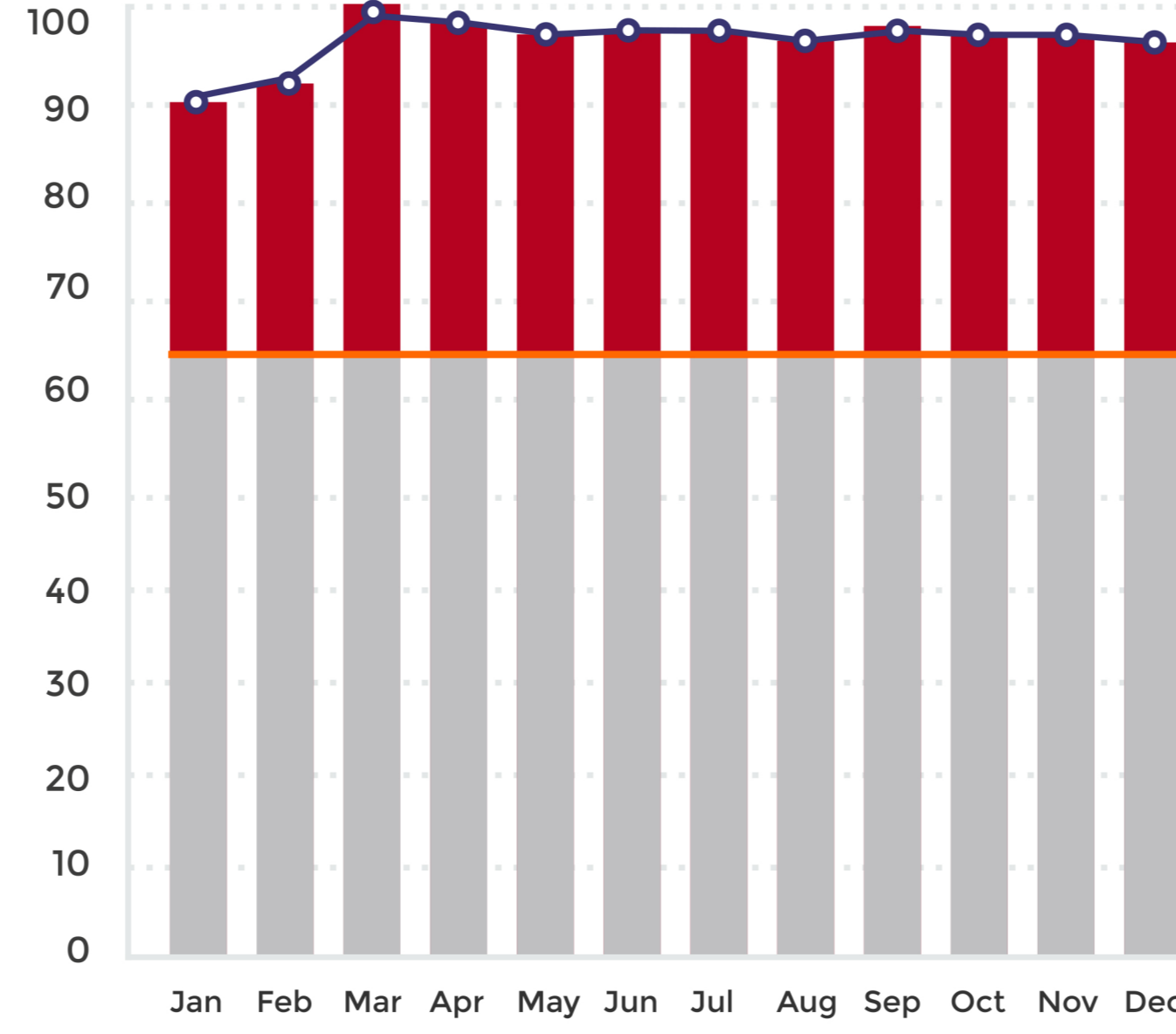

### HOW TO AVOID UNSAFE DRIVING VIOLATIONS:

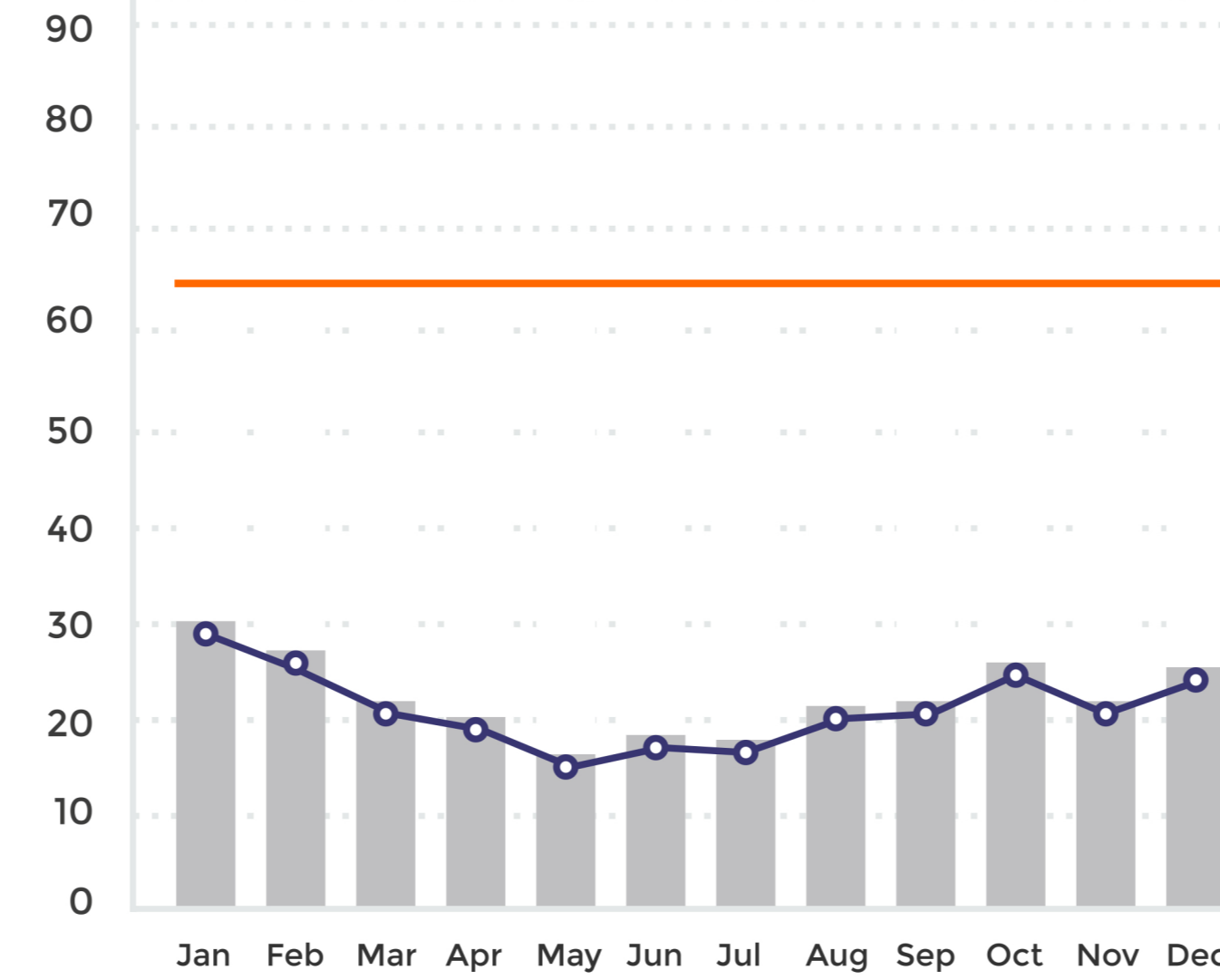
- No Speeding ! Stay at the speed limit
- Don't use handheld electronic device
- Don't drive in the left lane
- Never equip a CMV with a radar detector
- Always wear a seat belt
- Don't Fail to yield right of way
- Always obey a traffic control devices
- Avoid Improper turns
- Don't Follow too close
- Avoid Improper passing
- Use turn signal when change lanes
- Avoid Reckless Driving

### HOW TO AVOID HOS DRIVER VIOLATIONS:

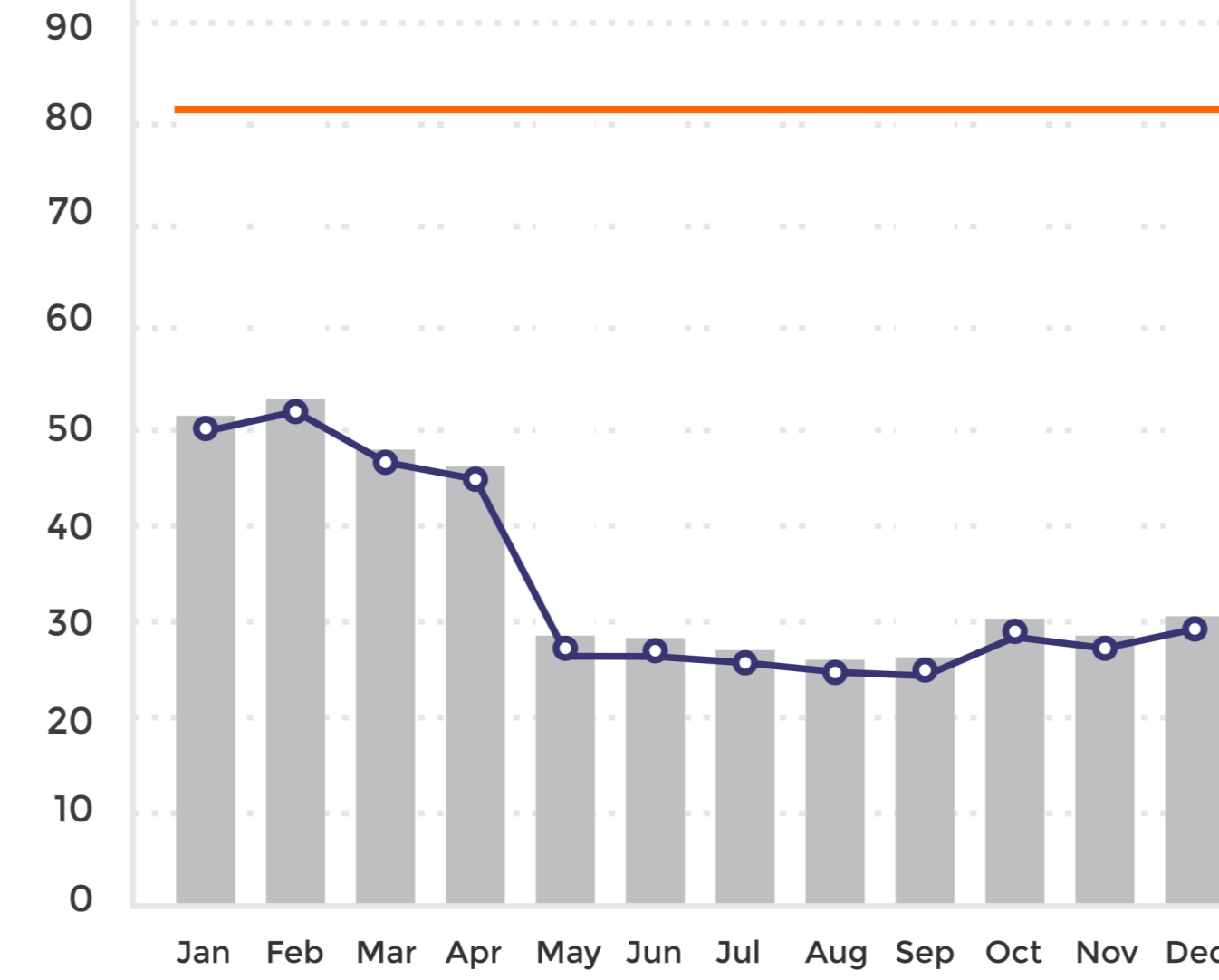
- Fill out time sheet
- Use Electronic Logging Device
- Do not skip weigh stations

### HOW TO AVOID DRIVER FITNESS VIOLATIONS:

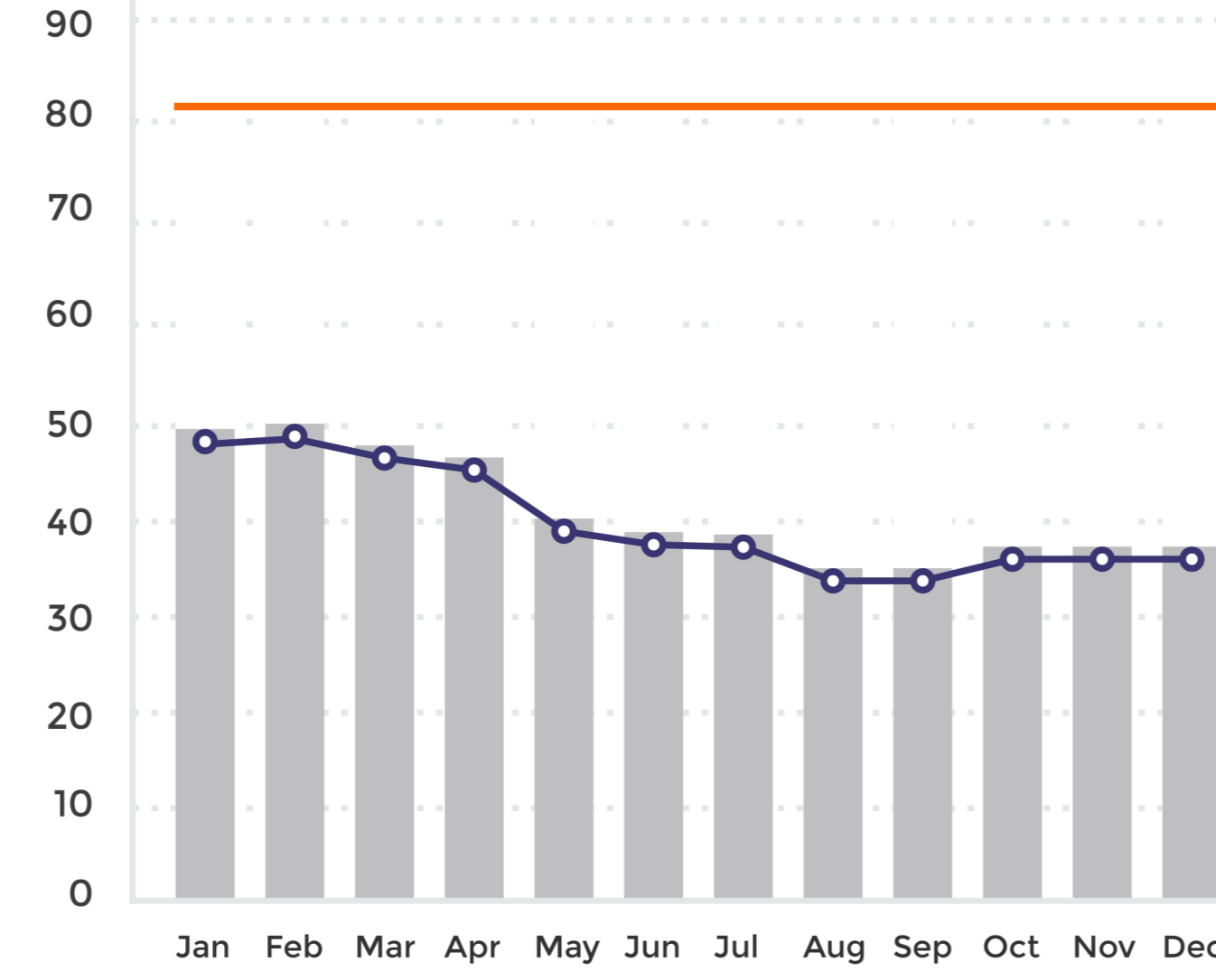
- Have medical card in your possession
- Must speak English
- Renew your medical examiner's certificate
- Must have CDL/DL in your possession
- Must have valid license for type of vehicle being driven
- Don't drive a CMV with suspended license
- Don't drive sleepy or in some other way physically impaired

### HOW TO AVOID CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES VIOLATIONS:

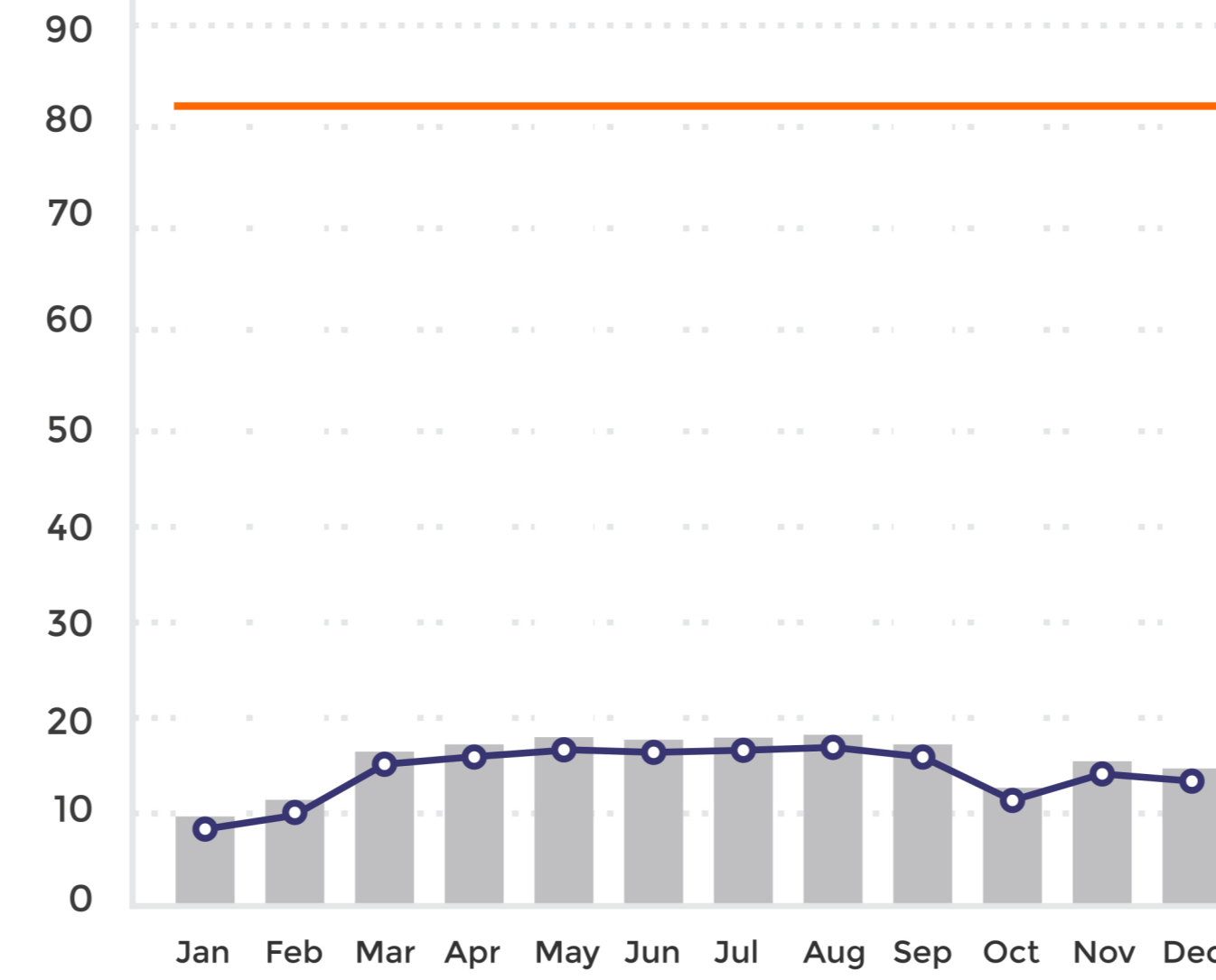
- DO NOT USE DRUGS - NEVER
  - DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE
- (The controlled substances for which tests are required under DOT regulations and this policy are currently cocaine, PCP, amphetamines, marijuana and opiates)

### HOW TO AVOID VEHICLE MAINTENANCE VIOLATIONS?

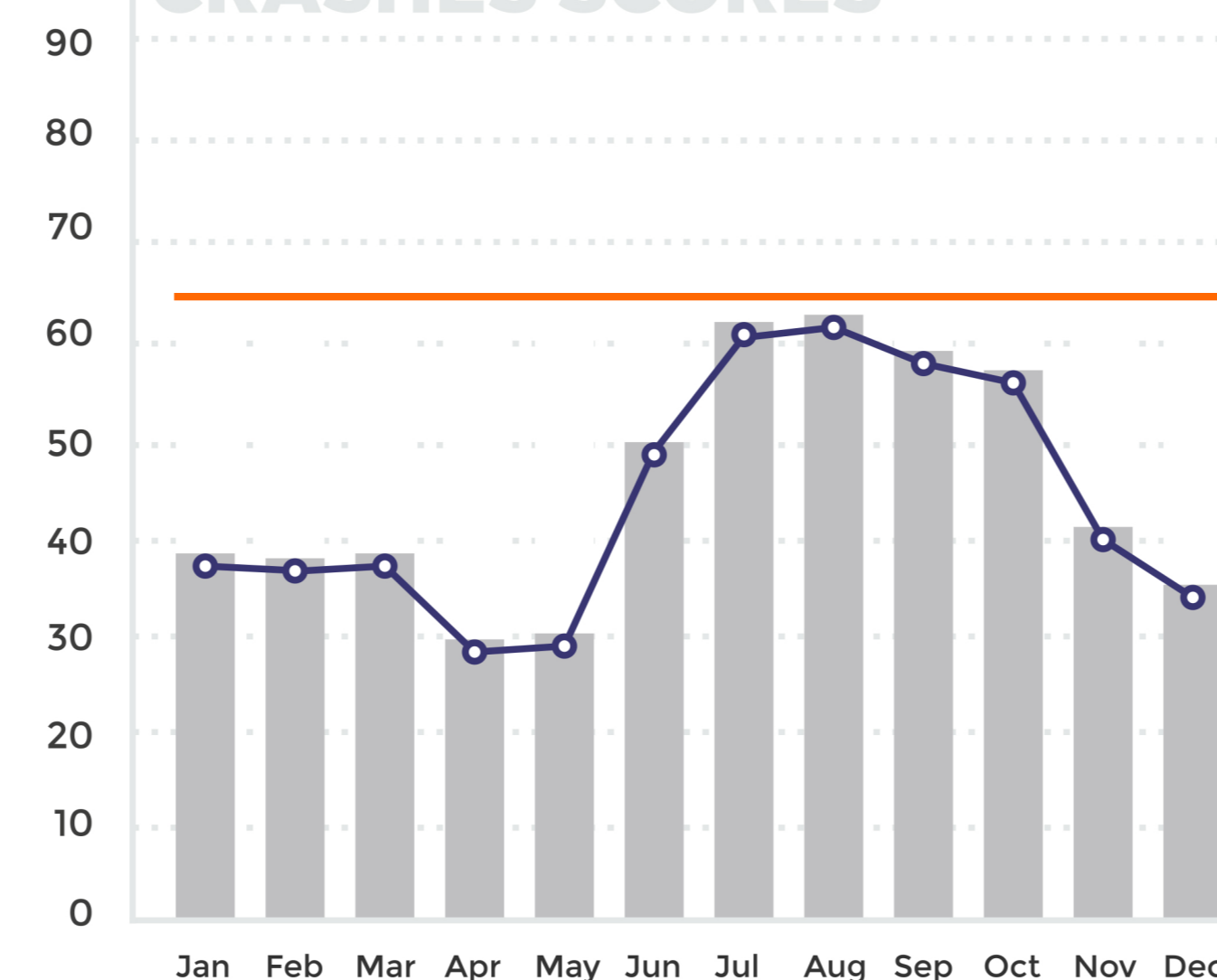
- Complete pre-trip and post-trip inspection every day
- Make sure there are no loose or hanging parts anywhere on the truck
- Check: lights
- Report any issues to dispatch at pre-trip and post-trip inspection
- leaks
- tires
- wipers
- windshield
- and mirrors

### SIX RULES TO AVOID TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS:

- Do not tailgate. Keep your distance. Leave a three-four second cushion between you and the vehicle in front of you.
- Be aware of blind spots.
- Adjust your speed to safely match weather conditions, road conditions, visibility, and traffic.
- Be courteous to other drivers.
- Look far ahead while driving. Scan at least 12 seconds ahead.
- Never break traffic rules.
